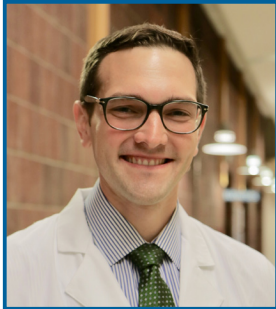


Anthony Sidari, MD
